Approval of Maintenance Compounds

Compound Trade Name: Inox Lubricant

Approvals:

This compound is approved under the following regulations and notices, subject to the conditions stated in this approval:

1. Authorised for use in meat, fish, game and game meat premises operating under the Meat Act regime
2. Regulation 11(4)(b) of the Animal Products Regulations 2000 and Regulation 18(4)(b) of the Animal Products (Regulated Control Scheme - Limited Processing Fishing Vessels) Regulations 2001
3. Clause 3(1) of the Animal Products (Specifications for Products Intended for Human Consumption) Notice 2002 and clause 4(1) of the Animal Products (Specifications for Limited Processing Fishing Vessels) Notice 2001

Conditions:

This may be used in edible areas. Before use, all edible product must be removed from the room. No edible product is permitted in the room while odours remain. Where incidental contact with the food surface occurs, the surface must be thoroughly cleaned and washed to ensure that no residue remains.

This approval may be withdrawn at any time due to unauthorised directions for use, or unsatisfactory performance, or any change in product formulation or manufacturer

The product must be used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and specifications. The label may include a statement to the effect that the product is authorised for use in premises licensed or approved under the Meat Act regime or registered under the Animal Products Act regime. Any statement made, however, must include the approval code and must be limited to one of the following options.

- NZFSA Approved C 12 (All animal product except dairy)
- MAF Approved C 12 (Fish Game Meat)

The latter statement may only be used until 31 October 2004.
